#### APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE AND AGREEMENT

The undersigned being the owner or occupier of land located within the above rural water district, hereby makes application to said District for water service and if water service is made available by said District, agrees to the following conditions:

- 1. Purchase or cause to be purchased one benefit unit for each water service at the price \$1,500.00.
- 2. Pay a minimum monthly meter charge, to be established by the Board of Directors, for each water service from the time service is made available by the District, and pay for additional water used at the rate set out in the rate schedule adopted by the Board of Directors. Any changes made in the minimum monthly water charge and rate scheduled by the Board of Directors of the District shall become a part of this Agreement as though fully set out herein.
- 3. The Rules and Regulations of the District provide that the District will read the water meters, service bill for water used shall be rendered by the District on the first day of the month following the month in which the water is used, and the undersigned agrees to pay said service bill on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month in which the bill is rendered, or be subject to a late charge of \$5.00. Failure of the District to submit a service bill shall not excuse the undersigned from his obligation to pay bill by the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month in which the bill is rendered shall result in discontinuance of the service. A \$30.00 charge for turning the water off and a \$30.00 for turning on will be placed on each meter when service is discontinued. If no payment is received for any particular benefit unit (meter) for a period of six (6) months, the meter will be pulled and the tap fee in effect at that time will be charged for re-installation of the meter. There will be a \$25.00 returned check fee applied to a customer's account for checks returned for NSF or Stop Payment.
- 4. The water service supplied by the District shall be for the sole use of the undersigned. The undersigned agrees that he will not extend or permit the extension of pipes for the purpose of transferring water from one property to another, nor will he share, resell, or sub-meter water to any other consumer. Each meter service shall supply water to only one residence or business establishment located on land within the District.
- 5. If, after water service is made available, the same is discontinued or disconnected for purpose, pursuant to the Bylaws and the Rules and Regulations of the District, reconnection shall be upon the conditions set out in the Bylaws and the Rules and Regulations of the District.
- 6. The undersigned agrees that he will make no physical connection between any private water system and the water system of the District. Representatives of the District may at any reasonable time come on the premises where the water is being used for the purpose of making inspection to enforce this provision. Violation of this provision shall be grounds for disconnection of service.
- 7. The laws of the State of Oklahoma, the Bylaws of the District, and the Rules and Regulations of the District, as presently existing, and as may be amended from time to time, are made a part of this agreement as though fully set out herein.

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- 8. A number shall be assigned to each meter on a tract of land to which each benefit unit is assigned.
- 9. Each applicant for water service must give a perpetual easement for the location of the water line crossing his land. Water meters are normally located five (5) feet inside the property line.
- 10. If at any time the volume or pressure drops to the danger level, the Board has the right to stop the Sale of meter taps on said water line.
- 11. No 45-degree angles for elevation will be permitted on our main line or under driveways.
- 12. Upon completion of the On-Site Sewage Treatment System, the homeowner and/or builder is required to provide Muskogee County Rural Water Dist. 4 a completed DEQ form 641-576A/S (On-Site Sewage Treatment System Inspection Report within 30 days of final inspection of sewage treatment system. Failure to comply may lead to disruption of water service.
